

## Job Interview at CyberFem Park

Belle gets the chance of a lifetime to work a technosexuals dream job - as one of very few humans working at CyberFem Park. But this isn't like any job interview she's ever had before.

What if your job interview was being conducted by an amazingly beautiful female android? And what if she would be your supervisor if you got hired? And what if you had to live at CyberFem Park to work there?

**Belle** *speaks in a normal speaking voice.*

**Winter** *speaks in a semi-monotone voice.*

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**Winter:** "Hello. Are you Belle Loxely?"

**Belle:** "Yes. Yes I am!"

**Winter:** "Hello Belle. My name is Winter. I am a CyberFem Model 700 Administrative Robot. I will be conducting the career consultation for the position of CyberFem Park Human Supervisor for which you have applied. Please come with me."

**Belle:** "Alright."

*(pause)*

**Winter:** "Belle, please sit down in that chair."

**Belle:** “Sure. You know... I feel a little overdressed now. If I had known you’d be wearing a bodysuit, I would have worn one too!”

**Belle:** (*awkward, nervous laugh*)

**Winter:** “Please wait while I access and retrieve your resume and data files.”

**Winter:** “You conducted online coding examination yesterday through our internet portal.”

**Belle:** “Yes. There were some... interesting problems there to solve... but I think I managed to code some good solutions to them.”

**Winter:** “The code you submitted has been analyzed by Model 700 robots in our Artificial Intelligence Research and Development Department. The quality of your code has been assessed to conform to our expectations with a degree of accuracy at or near 99%.”

**Belle:** “Oh... I’m pleased to hear that. I think that writing software is something that just comes naturally to me. I like to say I was born to code.”

**Winter:** “Processing. Born to code. Belle, is this an idiom?”

**Belle:** “Uh... yeah, I guess it is.”

**Winter:** “Belle, please refrain from the use of idioms and figures of speech during this career consultation. I am a robot, and I am not programmed to process communication such as that.”

**Belle:** “Okay. Sorry.”

**Winter:** “To return the topic of discussion back to the online coding examination you performed yesterday: you also completed the examination in two hours and twenty four minutes. That is an efficient use of time that was judged to be “impressive”.

**Belle:** “Thanks.”

*Pronunciation Station:*

*C++: See Plus Plus*

*ARM: like the word arm*

**Winter:** “Let us now discuss your resume. According to your education, you have a background in mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, computer science, and programming. You earned a Masters degree in robotics and in computer programming, and can code in C, C++, Python, and ARM assembly.

**Belle:** “Yes, yes, and yes. And I can also program in Lisp, if you want your robots programmed old-school.” (*nerdy laugh*)

**Winter:** “Processing. Old-school. Belle, is this an idiom?”

**Belle:** “Yeah, it is. Sorry about that.”

**Winter:** “Belle, please refrain from the use of idioms and figures of speech during this career consultation. I am a robot, and I am not programmed to process communication such as that.”

**Belle:** “I know... I’ll be more careful.”

**Winter:** “Your previous work experience indicates that you have held jobs at technology service companies and corporations. Your most recent and longest-held job was at Synergine Advancement Systems Incorporated as a technological development supervisor. Can you please tell me what manner of tasks you completed in that role?”

**Belle:** “Oh, of course. I was in charge of a team that developed business management software. My specific duties were to make sure the software was developed in time and within budget. I had to monitor my team members’ work for interoperability, and do a lot of bug hunting...”

**Belle:** “Sorry... you... understand what bug hunting is?”

**Winter:** “Yes Belle. Bug hunting is the process of identifying and eliminating errors in software during development.”

**Belle:** “Okay. Anyway, I also had to communicate back and forth with our clients to make sure we kept feature creep and scope creep to a minimum.”

**Winter:** “Processing. Understood. Belle, why did you leave that job?”

**Belle:** “Oh...” (*deep breath*) “I never got to see the Sun! I was working twelve hour days at a minimum, and I had to work out of a windowless office in the middle of a highrise downtown. I couldn’t take it any more.”

**Winter:** “Processing. Was this predicament causing you emotional distress?”

**Belle:** “Yes. Yes, you could say that.”

**Winter:** “Belle, you quit that job three months ago and have not held a job since applying for this position. What have you been doing in those three months?”

**Belle:** “Well, relaxing... I guess? Don’t take this personally, Winter, but you’re a robot. You don’t know what it’s like to be a human, and to be pushed to your breaking point every day for four years. A girl needs to... recuperate after that.”

**Winter:** “Processing. Understood. Humans have emotional needs in addition to their biological needs. This is one of the reasons why CyberFem Park is staffed almost entirely by robots.”

**Belle:** *(nervous laughter)*

**Winter:** “Let us now discuss what the prospective position of CyberFem Park Human Supervisor entails.”

**Belle:** “Okay.”

**Winter:** “First of all, as advertised, you will be required to reside here at CyberFem Park. You will be issued an employee suite to live in, and will be given complimentary meals. However, you will be considered to be ‘on call’ 24 hours a day on top of your regularly scheduled work shift of Monday to Friday 8 o’clock am to 5 o’clock pm.”

**Belle:** “Yes... that’s what... originally attracted me to this job... among other things. I have to ask, will there ever be overtime on projects?”

**Winter:** “Processing. No. Your regularly scheduled work

shifts will not be extended. However, when you are called in between your regular shifts by CyberFem Administrative Robots, you will be paid the overtime rate of time and a half for the work you perform at their request.”

**Belle:** “How often does that happen?”

**Winter:** “Processing. Accessing employee shift data. You can expect on average to be called upon 2.7 times per week in between your regular shifts by CyberFem Administrative Robots, for an average duration of 1.1 hours.”

**Belle:** “How many other humans work here? I know it’s almost all robots working here... but I’m curious.”

**Winter:** “There are currently seven humans employed by CyberFem Park. Three are employed in executive positions. Four are employed as Human Supervisors. The position you are applying for will be the eighth position filled by a human.”

**Belle:** “Wow. That’s not many at all. It’s kind of surprising.”

**Winter:** “Model 700 Administrative Robots such as myself have been programmed with highly advanced artificial intelligence programming specifically designed for administrative functionality, decision making, and managerial tasks.”

**Belle:** “That is... impressive. I have to ask though, what is the starting salary?”

**Winter:** “The base salary for CyberFem Park Human Supervisor is \$40,000 per year.”

**Belle:** “Oh. That’s kind of low.”

**Winter:** “Belle, please keep in mind that if you are hired by CyberFem Park, you will be given spacious and luxurious living quarters, free meals, and access to all of CyberFem Parks services and amenities.”

**Belle:** “Can you go into detail about the... services and amenities?”

**Winter:** “Yes Belle. As a human employee of CyberFem Park, you will be able to go to any Circuits Bar location on any floor, and order any meal for free. The robot waitresses will be programmed to recognize you, and will not charge you money. This same arrangement will be made at the Hidden Assets lingerie boutique on the main floor, and if you choose to order room service.”

**Winter:** “This is similar to how CyberFem Parks V.I.P. Visitor Service operates. You may also summon CyberFem Model 500 and Model 700 sex robots to your suite to use for your personal enjoyment, at any time after your regularly scheduled work shift and at no cost to you.”

**Belle:** “Oh... I didn’t... I wasn’t aware of that. Can you say that last part again just so I can be sure I heard you right?”

**Winter:** “Yes Belle. You may also summon CyberFem Model 500 and Model 700 sex robots to your suite to use for your personal enjoyment, at any time after your regularly scheduled work shift and at no cost to you.”

**Winter:** “A summation of the dress code for CyberFem Park’s Human Staff is as follows: Business Casual. More information will be available to you should CyberFem Park decide to hire you for this position.”

**Belle:** “Okay.”

**Winter:** “Do you have any additional questions, Belle?”

**Belle:** “So... is there, like, an office where the human staff work out of?”

**Winter:** “Yes, Belle. CyberFem Park’s hotel complex includes an underground robot manufacturing and repair facility. Part of this facility includes a small section cordoned off for use by CyberFem Park’s human employees.”

**Belle:** “So... no sunlight down there either.”

**Winter:** “No, Belle, but you are free to take your breaks outside.”

**Belle:** “Well,” *(light laugh)* “this is Miami, so there’s no shortage of sun here.”

**Winter:** “Do you have any additional questions, Belle?”

**Belle:** “Will I be expected to... repair any robots myself?”

**Winter:** “No, Belle. CyberFem’s robot manufacturing and repair facilities are off-limits to humans for hygienic purposes. When the need arises for our Human Staff to inspect damaged or defective robots, those robots are first extracted from these facilities and brought to our Human Staff to inspect and review.”

**Winter:** “I will also take this opportunity to inform you that even though CyberFem Park is staffed almost entirely by robots, CyberFem Park still adheres strictly to all relevant OSHA guidelines and industry safety directives. We are programmed to ensure that CyberFem Park will be a safe place for you to work.”

**Belle:** “Well, that’s good to hear.”

**Winter:** “Do you have any additional questions, Belle?”

**Belle:** “No, that should cover everything.”

**Winter:** “Processing. I will now calculate your application. This process will take several minutes. While this process is underway, would you like me to show you the employee suite that you will be granted should CyberFem Park choose to hire you?”

**Belle:** “Yes! Sure, I’d love to see that.”

**Winter:** “Please come with me.”

**Belle:** “Okay. Right behind you.”

**Winter:** “From this Administrative Robot Office area behind the Main Lobby Help Desk area, we will need to travel up a staircase to the second floor.”

**Belle:** “It’s so busy here today! Is it always bustling with visitors like this?”

**Winter:** “CyberFem Park has seen a steady increase in visitor rates over the last 18 months. Certain times of day are usually quite busy due to arrival times at the airport, which is nearby. CyberFem Park offers limousine service to and from the airport for CyberFem Park Visitors.”

**Belle:** *(giggles)* “That’s how I got here. I’m pretty sure my chauffeur was an android.”

**Winter:** “You are correct. CyberFem Park’s fleet of limousines are self-driving cars, so that robot was not actually driving. However, the service is regarded as a valuable asset to CyberFem Park. This way, please.”

**Winter:** “This is the second floor, which is comprised primarily of guest suites, but also guest suites converted to Human Staff suites. Suite number 205 has been prepared for the successful applicant of the position for which you are applying.”

*(pause)*

**Winter:** “Please step inside.”

**Belle:** “Oh, wow! It’s bigger than my apartment!”

**Winter:** “As I told you earlier in our conversation, it is quite spacious and luxurious.”

**Belle:** “You got that right!”

**Winter:** “As you can see, the foyer area leads to a living room area and a full kitchen. The bedroom is up those three carpeted stairs, and the washroom is accessible from the bedroom and the living room area.”

**Belle:** “Woah. Whoever gets this job is going to be pretty lucky.”

*(pause)*

**Belle:** “And... I just have to ask again... after my shift is over... I can just... order any sex androids I want up here with me?”

**Winter:** “Yes Belle.”

**Belle:** “And I can... like... open their access panels too? And take their faceplates off too?”

**Winter:** “Yes Belle.”

**Belle:** *(deep breath)* “Wow.”
